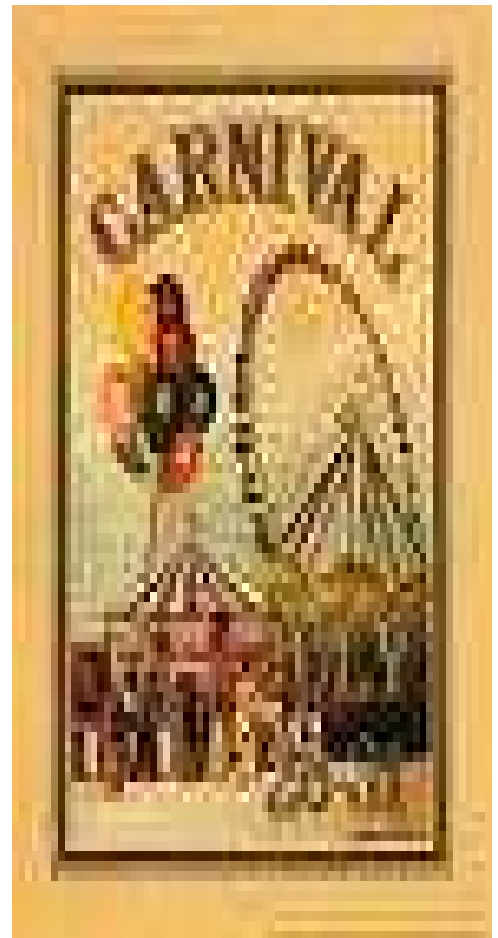

Fire District News

Meeting Highlights (June) – Budget & Finance; Due to our ability to reduce the claims to our Building & Vehicle Insurance, we received a check for a little over \$4,000.00 as a rebate for last years Insurance. The mid year Bond Interest Payment is due this month. Buildings & Grounds; Tree's and shrubbery have been planted. The exhaust cover over the stove has been installed, but removed for the summer months. Reminder, once the cold weather comes back, the panels will be placed over the stove, but will need to be removed when using the stove. Personnel; The employee's held their annual meeting with the Fire District. The Committee is investigating hiring additional people to cover open shifts. Policies: The District is currently working on several new or updated Policies. Once approved, they will be shared with the Membership. Safety: The Chief had a meeting in June to address the proposed Rehab Policy and the pending Rope Legislation. Several idea's came out of the meeting that will be shared at a later date.

Ambulance Study – The committee met in June to review the Survey that has been created. Deputy Chief Lis-sow continues to drive this project forward.

Apparatus Replacement – The Committee has shared a proposal to extend the replacement date of P-263 out 5 more years, and review that decision in 3 years. The Fire District moved to accept the committee's recommendation. There was a list of items that P-263 should complete in order to extend its life. That maintenance will be scheduled. In addition, the Committee is now reviewing R-268, and will provide that assessment sometime in September.

Fitness Equipment – Commissioner Harter is working with G&G Fitness to develop a Train-The-Trainer program for Hilton people. Commissioners Ward & Harter are working on a Policy that will encompass the use of the equipment. Just as a reminder, no-one will be allowed to use the Fitness Equipment until they have received proper instruction on the operation and safety of the equipment. If you are interested in becoming a "Trainer", please see Commissioner Harter.

Security Camera – Commissioner Ward has developed an RFP to install Security Camera's in and around the Fire Station. A Legal Notice was placed in the Suburban News requesting sealed RFP's. The requests are due on July 7th, and will be discussed at that point. Once finalized, we will share more information with the membership.
